## ALLEE OR AVENUE:

- A formal walk bordered by trees, planted in 2 parallel rows
- use to frame scenic vista, statue, or focal point
- designed to be permanent feature
- put hedge row along outside allee to strengthen design, add depth
  - shade tolerant shrubs: mento barberry, dwarf winged eponymous, ribes alpinum
  - perennials, hostas, ladys mantle, goatsbeard, coralbells, creeping jenny
- Sequence: slows down direction, but by repetition, it carries the eye forward:
  - sequential rooms=made of clipped hedges
  - formal meander-break up length of perimeter hedge
