
WINDOW BOXES:

- add charm, color, detail to front traditional houses
- break up broad imposing facade of house
- require lot watering and fertilizing to keep them looking good
-
- to keep from blocking windows, limit plant height to 10" or less, put trailing plants in front

- Window boxes that are up high benefit from a simple planting, as you see a mass from a distance, not individual plants. *Vinca maculatum* makes a great trailer. They grow very long; their chartreuse variegated leaves are large and interesting. Deborah Silver
