The Cooper-Young Garden Club is accepting applications for the "**C Y We Beautify**" **Grant Program**. We encourage all residents and civic groups to submit your creative ideas to beautify our neighborhood with plantings, art, and creative solutions to neighborhood concerns.

This program is funded by proceeds from our annual Cooper Young Garden Walk. Eligible projects can win award amounts from **\$50-\$500**, until we reach our grant limit of \$2,000.

"C Y We Beautify" Application Guidelines and Directions:

The Cooper Young Garden Club has set aside \$2,000 yearly to provide small-dollar grants, not to exceed \$500 per grant. Groups and projects must meet the following criteria to be eligible for a CY Garden Club Beautification Grant:

- The residents and project must be located within the Cooper Young "footprint", specifically with the boundaries of Southern to Central Avenue, and McLean Blvd. to East Parkway Avenue.
- The project must be related to: gardening, beautification, safety, or enhance our community. It cannot be to the benefit of an individual's personal garden or property unless it fall's into the above areas. Commercial properties are not eligible.
- The project must be visible from the street.
- The project must include matching funds equal to the requested amount. This can include volunteer time (sweat equity calculated at \$15/hour), or contributions for the same identified project.
- Only completed applications will be considered.
- Please note that submission of a completed application signifies adherence and agreement to the guidelines of the project. All decisions by CY Garden Club Board are final.
- Please submit the completed form to CY Beautification Grant, 899 Blythe, Memphis, TN 38104.
- The CY Garden Walk Board, which meets monthly, will review + respond to your request within 4-6 wks.
- Projects that are funded will receive 1/3 the amount up front, and the final 2/3 when the project is completed and the project survey form is turned in.
