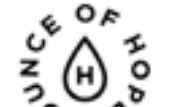

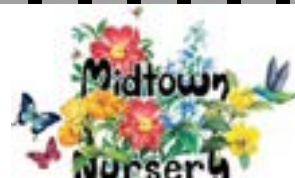
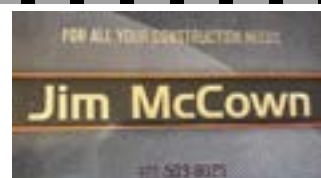

**2** - 1871 York  
**Jeanie Williams & Harrison Walford, c1921**  
 Curved beds wrap gracefully around the garden contain lots of shade plants. The couple built a patio and deck and slowly keep adding beds.

**3** - 1866 Evelyn 🎓🎁📌  
**Elizabeth Silverman, c1966**  
 French style garden. Herbs, flowers, and veggies abound. Sit near the tranquil pond, meander among the raised beds, and listen to the chickens clucking. **Drawing for Farmers Defense garden sleeves.**

**4** - 1929 Evelyn 🎓  
**Dana Wilson, c1921**  
 Screened porch, seating areas, edibles, chickens, raised beds and lots of native plants. Jim McCown: Builder, Landscaping: Urban Earth

**5** - 1976 Evelyn 🎓  
**Karen “Bottle” Capps, c1920**  
 My garden goal is to spend very little on the yard, seeds only. I've added a “Free Little Plant” stand. Art pieces, natives, roses, and edibles.

**Brad & Sarah Gilmer, c1930**  
 Dry creek, two Asian-inspired wooden bridges. Magnolia, azaleas, caladiums, ferns, cone flowers, a 14-foot palm tree, gardenias, ferns. New screened porch. **Jim McCown, builder.**

**7** - 2020 Evelyn 📌  
**Susannah White, c1912**  
 This manicured Craftsman bungalow has a stone walkway and porch. Evergreen shrubs frame the front porch. Be sure to visit the back garden.

**8** - 2040 Evelyn  
**Mallory Sharp & Rhones Aur, c1912**  
 Charming blue bungalow has front beds chock full of colorful annuals, tea olives, rosemary, star jasmine, shrubs, and cute concrete toadstools.

**9** - 2051 Evelyn 🎓  
**Jim Brasher & Laura Terry, c1918**  
 We want our garden to reflect Cooper-Young's artistic uniqueness. It's our private refuge, containing a new pergola, local art, azaleas, cherry trees, hydrangeas, roses, and annuals.

**10** - 2097 Elzey  
**Frank & Phyllis Godsey, c1932**  
 The river rock bed boasts a large birdhouse for an eagle, huge decorative boulders, pots and flowers galore. The back garden is low maintenance and whimsical.

**11** - 2099 Elzey  
**Benjamin Rednour & Amy Schaftlein, c1920**  
 Grassless Front garden. Natives, hydrangeas, azaleas, cone-flowers, Mexican petunias, Black-eyed susans, mums, and tiger lilies fill the front garden.

 Red, composite, Queen Anne Cottage delights with raised timber beds and whimsical ornaments. Screen porch and colorful flowers abound in the back.

 Lawn-Yawn! This garden will inspire you to go native. Plant a native redbud instead of a Bradford Pear and create habitat for wildlife. Your landscape is an opportunity, not a liability.

**Donald Thomas, c1920**  
 American chestnut, tulip poplar, Big leaf magnolia, bald cypress and paw paw trees, may apples, trillium, red buckeye, 6 species of ferns, wild ginger, money plants, and more.

**Megan Mulligan & Kelly Carter, c1920**  
 Large Yoshino Cherry tree and numerous perennials welcome you through the painted teal garden gate.

**16** - 1930 Nelson 📌  
**Kelly & David Lindsey, c1928**  
 Stone raised bed, chock full of shade plants. Swinging caldron planter, chickens, edibles, azaleas, roses and more.

**17** - 1980 Nelson 📌  
**John & Tyrina Browning, c1920**  
 This front garden shows the owners' creativity, from the unusual glass fountain to handmade gates, stone walkway, and lawn-less front garden. Chinese Fringe Tree, azaleas.

**Rev. Edie Love, c2008**  
 Sage-green house, perfect for an impromptu wedding, easily officiated by the owner/minister. Front beds maintained by the Bramble and Blooms Flower Farm.

**Matt Chamberlain & David Randolph, c1922**  
 Craftsman bungalow features eyebrow dormers. Too many plants to list. Four urns always filled with colorful annuals. Concrete toadstools and unique wooden gate.

**Connie Arduini & Jimmy McCown, c1922**  
 The front garden features all shade plants, unique porch. Large screened porch. Blue fence, perennials and sculptural flowers. **Construction by Jim McCown. 1989 Red Mazda RX7**

**Sam & Lacey Moody, c1910**  
 Stone wall and matching front urns. Dogwood, Peggy Martin rose on the columns, blue salvia, peony, azaleas, sweet olives, and a gigantic hosta that everyone admires.

**22** - 2075 Nelson 🎓  
**Katie Kidd & Colin Ross, c1910**  
 We created a garden for my ailing grandmother, that brought us all joy. After she passed we decided to use some of what was graciously left to me to renovate our garden in her honor. Landscaping by Urban Earth.

**Ryan Jones & Abagail Kirk, c1910**  
 The white bungalow framed by white picket fence and aqua gate has a tropical beach vibe. European Palms, blue pots, hanging ferns, & colorful flowers. **1966 F100 Pickup Truck**

**Steve Reichling, c. 1905**  
 Pink Queen Ann embraces both natives and tropical plants. Native azalea, Chinese Windmill palms, live oaks, hostas, and garden art. More surprises in the back garden.

**Judi & Buzz Shellabarger c1909**  
 Our aim is to have a “nature-respectful” garden. We save our leaves, have natural wildlife piles, and have added more native plants. **We are a part of homegrownationalpark.org.**

**Demetrias Boyland & Brian Sykes, c1910**  
 The brick-lined retaining wall edges and defines the simple, serene landscape. Cast iron plant, ornamental grasses, hostas, lenten roses, dogwood, and sedums catch the eyes.

 Simple stacked stone helps erosion and defines the space. Concrete path divides the curved planting area. White gardenias, blue hydrangeas, yellow st. john's wort, and azaleas.

 Japanese maple, holly, clematis, hostas, salomon seal, phlox, begonias, irises, caladiums, later vine, jack-in-the-pulpit, and many plants grow statuary, pond, and wrought-iron bench.

 Hosta bed around huge oak tree planted in 1948. Curved landscape bed, close to house, has wood ferns and a miniature pink azalea tree.

 Eclectic garden is the perfect classroom for the young daughters. Smell-ables, pollinator plants, plants with texture, and edibles. Jingling petticoat sculpture.

Sitting on a houseplant-filled porch sipping a cocktail is relaxing, best enjoyed with friends.

**34** - 2083 Young 🎓  
**Jason & Amber Whitworth, c1912**  
 The garden is all about family living in the city — outdoor kitchen, trampoline, trees and shrubs, Azaleas, boxwoods, loropetalum, grapes, dogwoods, kerria, pecan, hollies, redbuds and elms.

**35** - 2093 Young 🎓  
**Sai & Georgene Cachola, c1910**  
 Azaleas, hydrangeas, chaste tree, leyland cypress, river birch, Japanese Katsura, crepe myrtles, dwarf Magnolia, and sky pencil holly. Deck, complete with a tiki bar.

**36** - 1851 Felix  
**Audra Brown & Will Kalish, c1908**  
 Charming, yellow cottage pops with clever cobalt blue planters filled with agaves, yuccas, and flowers. Roses, sage, rosemary, hydrangeas and black-eyed susans.

**37** - 1854 Felix 🎓🐦  
**Marie Dennon & Patrick Gridley, c1912**  
 Craftsman bungalow with full porch and swing. In the back, discover chickens, raised beds, lots of edibles, natives, and a stylish shed built by Mike Larrivee.

**38** - 1891 Felix  
**Leander Starr & Elise Blatchford, c1912**  
 Younger featuring a poetry post where a new poem is posted weekly. A mix of edibles, perennial herbs, bulbs, native flowers, specialty shrubs and roses.

**39** - 1902 Felix  
**Bryce & Judy Stewart, c1902**  
 The limited plant selection and color palette make for strong design and low maintenance. Lantana, Mexican petunias, perilla magilla, four o'clocks, and purple heart.

**40** - 1935 Felix  
**David Zaleski, c1935**  
 Stone path and center medallion invites the visitor to take a turn and enjoy this bench seat surrounded by blueberry shrubs, crepe myrtle's, hydrangeas, and boxwoods.

**41** - 2058 Felix  
**Mike Oliver & Melissa Wilbanks, c1912**  
 This teal/gold house welcomes you with colorful porch furniture, art, and annuals. Enjoy a dry rock river bed, and mobile. Japanese maple, junipers, hostas, and purple heart.

**42** - 2097 Felix  
**Tina Collins, c1910**  
 Yellow bungalow is bordered by metal fence. Walk through the covered carport to see the raised beds growing edibles and the gravel patio and lounge area.

**43** - 2100 Felix  
**Ric & Jo Chetter, c1910**  
 This is a hidden fairy-tale cottage that could be mistaken as being found in a clearing in the forest. Green hedges surround this property. The lawn-less garden has ivy ground cover and boxwood.

**44** - 1888 Walker 🎁  
**Ceylon Mooney, c1912**  
 Almost lawn-less front yard combines native plants, edibles, and flowers. The slightly wild plantings encourage wildlife and pollinators and make the garden feel more spacious.

**Beola Hicks, c1922**  
 Tidy gray/blue house has a brick lined walkway flanked by arbores, a bottle tree, bird bath, camelia, and a flag. The screened porch is the perfect way to enjoy the seasons.

**Phoebe & David Moore, c1924**  
 Front yard: two large tea camellias, a flying dragon shrub, a pomegranate tree, hydrangeas, roses, and an herb garden.

**Cathy & Steve Easterwood, c1922**  
 Cozy cottage garden: hollies, viburnum, tulips, oak leaf hydrangeas, palm ferns, crepe myrtles, annuals, nandinas, dianthus, birdbath, and art.

 Easy to maintain garden for a busy owner. This corner lot welcomes you with roses, art, peonies, flowering shrubs and 4-season color. Look for the surprise in the back yard!

 Bungalow with yellow door and concrete planters. The border rocks represents a foster child cared for in this home. Braided white roses and cactus are the start of this young garden.

 The arbor beckons you to the back garden — a screened porch, rock garden, fire pit and tons of plants. Crepe Myrtles, hydrangeas, natives, roses, rosemary, ivy, and annuals.

 The front and back gardens surprise with color and whimsy. Camellias, coleus, hostas, ferns, loropetalums, hydrangeas, peonies, boxwoods, and heucheras delight visitors.

**Jimmy Thomason & Tommy Langston, c1926**  
 Owner designed urn and planter boxes. Hosta and fern shade gardens, fountain, a gazebo, chickens, natives, a Ming tree, and a featured “Tree of Heaven”.

**Lori Connolly & Lynn Jackson, c1924**  
 This colorful container collection packs a wallop of color. There are black-eyed susan's, cactus, roses, Mexican heather, red maple, irises, and a yucca.

**59** - 2160 Nelson 📌  
**Jessica & Matt Read, c1922**  
 The garden features an outdoor rabbit hutch, raised beds, and a relaxing fire pit area. The front porch holds a swinging bed swing. Raised edible beds were added this year.

**Angie Wallick, c1922**  
 Hanging baskets, ironwork window boxes, concrete planters full of colorful annuals, and hand-built birdbouses by her father. Backyard, fence art, shed, and back porch was added.
